Please read through our rules and understand them before engaging in the community.

Our Global Code of Conduct (GCC) ensures respectful and inclusive interactions within all spaces managed by the Global Operations Team (G.O.T.) and by other teams within the community (ie: FO, TIT), including:



# **GLOBAL CODE OF CONDUCT (GCC)**

▲ Our GCC is straightforward.

## X This is not a place for

- X Harassment of any kind,
- X Abusive language, offensive comments, or unwelcome personal remarks,
- X Threats and intimidation.
- 💢 Racist jokes or comments,
- 💢 Disruptive or inappropriate behavior (extreme negativity, stalking, spamming, unwelcome sexual attention),
- X Drug or illegal activity related posts,
- 💢 Sacrilegious joking,
- X Lack of sportsmanship spirit,
- X Physical contact without consent.

### Important guidelines

- Respect everyone's boundaries and cease communication if asked,
- All users must be legal years of age or older based on each platform's terms of service.
- Do not spam any of the channels, pages, or lobby with repeated posts or comments of gibberish.
- Please make sure you're posting in the correct category for your respective posts and stay on topic.
- Do not post the same content (video, links, info, or other) multiple times in a row or within the same day.

#### **⚠** Tone markers

Reading tone in an all-text medium can be complicated sometimes. While tone markers are not mandatory at all, our community may use them from time to time, ie: /j or /jk (joking), /s (sarcasm), /gen (genuine), /? (asking for tone).

#### What can you do

Please report any situation to a member of the moderator or admin team of the platform in which you witness and/or experience a potential misbehavior by someone.

If necessary, you may also contact the Global Operations Team (G.O.T.) Board of Trustees (admins).



#### 🔔 What we will do

Members who break any of these rules and guidelines (GCC) may result in either a warning, timeout, or be permanently removed from the community.

Our moderators and admins are encouraged to begin with the least punitive measures necessary. At the discretion of the server owner or moderation team, they are also empowered to accelerate to any measure commensurate with the degree of infraction.

Follow our simple rules and we'll all have a good time!

# Further Guidelines And Examples

While the above Global Code of Conduct (GCC) should cover the vast majority of cases, the following items are provided as additional examples and possible scenarios for the aid of the moderation team.

These are not an exhaustive list of items that would be considered an infraction to the Global Code of Conduct (GCC), but are illustrative.

- $\times$  Age or other guidelines as set by the community platform such as Discord or Facebook (Meta) or a local game
- X Any language used in an abusive manner towards another community member. ■
- X Offensive comments related to gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, mental illness, neuro(a)typicality, physical appearance, body size, age, race, or religion.
- 💢 Unwelcome comments regarding a person's lifestyle choices and practices, including those related to food, health, parenting, drugs, and employment.
- X Deliberate misgendering or use of rejected names.
- X Drug or illegal activity related posts.
- ✗ Gratuitous or off-topic sexual images or behavior in spaces where they are not appropriate.
- X Physical contact without consent or after a request to stop.
- X Threats of violence.
- 💢 Incitement of violence towards any individual, including encouraging a person to commit suicide or to engage in selfharm.
- X Deliberate intimidation.
- X Stalking or following.
- imes Harassing photography or recording, including logging online activity for harassment purposes.
- X Sustained disruption of discussion.
- X Unwelcome sexual attention.
- 💢 Pattern of inappropriate social contact, such as requesting/assuming inappropriate levels of intimacy with others
- X Continued one-on-one communication after requests to cease.
- XDeliberate "outing" of any aspect of a person's identity without their consent except as necessary to protect vulnerable people from intentional abuse.
- X Publication of non-harassing private communication.
- X Disparagement humor, which makes a punchline of the marginalized.
- X Any continuation of a joke after a request to stop.
